

Chenango County 4-H Leaders Association Scholarship Application

4-H Scholarships are awarded to graduating High School Seniors who have been active in the Chenango County 4-H Program and will be continuing their formal education at a two or four year technology school, college, university or certificate degree program. **Scholarships will be disbursed after proof of successful completion of the first semester.**

HOW TO APPLY

Part I. Submit a one-page biography about your experiences, achievements, and contributions to your school, family, club and community. Be sure to include how long you have been in 4-H and how 4-H has helped you personally and with your accomplishments. **Must be typed.**

Part II. Attach TWO letters of recommendation.

- a) One should be from your Club Leader, if you have been a club member; or if you have NOT been a club member, from a 4-H Adult Volunteer or Staff Member who has sufficient knowledge of your involvement in 4-H,
- b) The other recommendation should be from someone other than a family member who you feel can describe your strengths as an individual.

Part III. Respond to the following question:

In a brief essay describe what your plans are for continuing with your education. Please include how your 4-H experience has helped to prepare you and how it may help you in achieving your goals in the future.

Part IV.

- a) Submit a copy of your college acceptance letter.
- b) Submit a head shot photograph.
