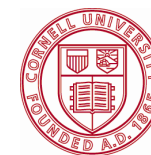
By March, 2014 the project will launch 3 more new Community Gardens throughout the county, as well as several satellite container gardens.

Management of the garden later transferred to CCE Chenango. This garden was expanded to 44 plots in 2010. Plots are available NOW for new gardeners!

The Oxford Community Garden started in Spring 2010, has 19 plots, and is located on Route 12 just south of the Waste Water Treatment Facility.

**Seeking Partners and Sites for
3 New Community Gardens
And Container Gardens**

By March, 2014 the project will launch a total of 5 new Community Gardens throughout the county, 2 more in 2012 and 1 in 2013. We are currently seeking partners and sites for these gardens.

We are also seeking partners for Container Gardens. These would be in locations where people live close together and have limited access to garden plots such as senior housing centers, apartment complexes, mobile home parks, etc. or at workplaces.

Container gardens will be provided along with instruction on building and maintaining container gardens.

Cost for Participants

Community Garden participants are asked to make a \$20 donation each spring for the use of their plot. Low-income families/individuals can either "Adopt-A-Crop" to donate to local food pantries or "Adopt-A-Chore" instead of the cash donation.

Container Garden expenses will be determined with each partner on a case-by-case basis.
