EQUIPMENT and ATTIRE:

Smooth snaffles with bridged reins are allowed in ALL classes on any age horse at this event. Reings on all horses must be split or romal, no closed Roping reins.

Ranch Attire is suggested/encouraged for the show but casual attire is allowd during the clinic. Neat jeans, boots, hat or helmet, belt, long sleeved collared shirt are standard as minimum. Tail Extensions, bands, braids and hoof polish are **not** allowed. Silver Tack will be permitted but is highly discouraged. Leg protection is permitted on the horse during ranch riding and reining as well as during the clinic.
