

Chenango County 4-H Market Animal Auction Program

“Points To Success”

Sale Order and “Points to Success” Incentive Breakdown:

The sale order for each species: (1st) Champion Project Animal, (2nd) Champion Live Placing Animal, (3rd) Reserve Champion Project Animal, (4th) Reserve Champion Live Placing Animal, (5th downward) ranked by points. Points Tie Breakers: (1st) Live Placing, then (2nd) Showmanship, then (3rd) random selection.

Champion Project Animals in each species will be chosen on a point system using the following points scale:

20 points per educational livestock-related program or fair/show attended. **Maximum 200 total points.**

- Examples include:
 - NYS Livestock Summit Zooms
 - Showing your project animal at other fairs or shows
 - New York Beef Producers Association Annual Conference (Educational Breakout Sessions)
 - Livestock Skillathon Practices

10 points per community service hour completed. **Maximum 50 points *per species*.**

- Examples include:
 - Community Clean-Up Projects
 - Helping at local animal shelters
 - Visiting or making cards for local nursing home

50 points for completing a 4-H Public Presentation, participating in a livestock clinic, attending a NYS 4-H Animal Science Event, or doing a marketing workshop. **Maximum 150 points.**

- Examples include:
 - Other County/Surrounding Counties Workshops/Clinics
 - Livestock Showmanship Clinic
 - A+ Pig Clinic
 - Animal Crackers in Cornell
 - Public Presentations
 - Marketing Workshops

If you ever need clarification or want to confirm whether an event qualifies for points, please feel free to reach out to the 4-H Office or a member of the 4-H Livestock Auction Committee. Dairy Bowl & Horse Bowl do not qualify as a qualified educational event for points. Educational programs must be livestock-based. Participants must complete at least three educational qualifying events from the Points to Success list.
