PROCESSING, TRANSPORT & REMINDERS

- Livestock have reserved processing dates at a USDA-inspected facility
- Poultry is sold fully processed
 - All other animals are sold live
 - Optional trucking to the processor is available
 - Processing fees are paid directly to the processor

HELPFUL REMINDERS

- Arrive early to review the sale order and processing options
- Businesses should provide correct invoicing information
- Buyers are recognized during and after the auction

HOW THE AUCTION WORKS

Buyer Registration

Stop at the Registration Table before the auction to receive your bidder number and sale catalog.

Sale Order

Animals are sold by lot based on points earned through educational activities, clinics, and project work achieved by each child.

(Official order listed in the catalog.)

Bidding

Raise your bidder number to place a bid. Sales are final when the auctioneer declares the animal "SOLD!"

Pricing

All animals are sold by the pound, unless otherwise noted.

Multiple Purchases

Buyers may purchase one or multiple animals.



ADD-ONS: SUPPORT WITHOUT BUYING

Add-ons allow you to financially support a specific 4-H member without purchasing their animal.

- Available at the Add-On Table during the auction
- May be given to any exhibitor
 - Added directly to the exhibitor's final check
 - Please list the exhibitor's full name
